UDOT Requirements

- Pick up large trash bags by Tom Loken's front door starting May 15.
 Tom's address: 6532 S. Moose Creek Lane in Silver Fork
- 2. Leave large trash bags on the highway shoulder for pick-up. Close bags securely. The last pick-up day will be June 1.
- 3. If you can't lift something (ex: a tire), leave it on the road with a large trash bag wedged under it as a marker.
- 4. If you use plastic grocery bags for pick-up and dispose of them in an area dumpster, that would save UDOT many trips up the canyon. (Thanks!)
- 5. Remember to wear gloves! (Water bottle and hat help too.)
