REPORTS

UPD Report -Lee Arnold reported on June 12,2021 the Drop 13 ½ marathon will take place in Big Cottonwood. It will begin near Solitude at 0600 hours. Runners will stay on the downhill lane throughout the canyon. Traffic will be escorted by UPD both uphill and downhill in the uphill lane. The runners should be out of the canyon by 0900 hours. The race will end in Cottonwood Heights.

UPD will have two Officers missing from the canyon unit. One is being deployed (one year tour) and the other will be gone on maternity leave. Please be patient and allow a little extra time to respond to the needs of the canyon as we will be shorthanded for a while.

UDOT is planning to have the Guard road open by the Memorial Day. This date is not set in stone so don't be too disappointed if it don't happen. It all depends on the weather.

We are looking forward to being a part of the Brighton Parade this year. We have two UPD Motors to help with the parade this year.

We had a close call of a residential burglary, a quick thinking neighbor got a photo of the vehicle with a clear image of the license plate. The officer completed an investigation and it turned out to be a relative who was not supposed to be at the cabin. BUSINESS

Beaver Habitat Restoration at Willow Lake – Robby Edgel, Utah DWR and Lise Brunhart Plan is to bring beavers back to Willow Lake. Much of the work Robby does is through the Utah's Watershed Restoration Initiative. Beaver reintroduction is important because it aids in erosion and creates side channels to feed big game species, especially moose. Also upland game habitat, fish and native aquatic habitat and will improve. Beaver dams create firebreaks. Robby introduced a book, "*Eager*" Ben Goldfarb and encouraged everyone to read it. Beaver Dam Analogs (BDAs or man-made beaver dams) are prosed for Willow Lake. Pond Levelers and Culvert Protectors are installed to help with flooding and allows the beavers to stay without causing damage. Robby will also be working on fire mitigation and forest health. Robby thanked the Central Wasatch Commission for funding the project. Jenna asked if Robby could share the slide of the natural fire break to share out with the community.

SL County Liaison – Jocelyn Romero- County Ordinance update to how many livestock on private property. And SL County Planning Commission Council membership requirements there is a hearing date scheduled.

Adopt-A-Highway Reminder- This is our 34 year doing the cleaning. Tom Loken will have the big trash bags available near his front door for you to pick up on April 25 (6532 S. Moose Creek Lane in Silver Fork). The deadline for the trash pickup along the roadway by UDOT is June 1st.

Trail Adoption- We are now the proud caretaker of the Butler Fork Trail. We will abide by USFS and CCF rules and provide aid only under their direction.

4th of July Parade- will be held on July 3rd. A trail race will also be held that day. **3rd of July Breakfast & Parade.** The Parade Committee meeting came up with the following decisions:

Resort Updates

Randy Dole -Reported a lot of work and upkeep is happening on the hill. Brighton resort is happy to help with the organization of the 4th of July parade and celebration. Kim Dole has been very helpful with the breakfast.

Other Community Input

Emergency Ops Committee. Jane announced that the Brighton Emergency Planning and Jim Woodward will conduct a simulation about what actions we would take and what we will be doing if there was an actual fire in our canyon. June 14th all members of the committee will be present.

Brighton Institute – Carolyn needs volunteers help with Brighton Days, possibly July 23 and July 24; we may shrink it to July 24th. Some artists have created the paintings for banners, so kids can put their face in a designated spot to create pictures. Booths will be created to share something about Big Cottonwood Canyon. Success of Brighton Days will depend on community support. Please share some names with Carolyn of names of people in your community who may want to have a booth. Lecture sites are still on hold because of covid safety concerns.
