SNOW REMOVAL ADVISORY

Most canyon roofs are built to withstand the extra weight of snow. But extreme snow years can be of concern for weight and roofalanches. Please watch out for roof cornices, overhangs, and roofalanche risks around your home!

Calculation of Snow Weight

12" x 12" x 12" block of average snow = about 20 lbs. (varies by water content)

Average roof size = 1400 sq.ft.

Possible snow depth on roof: = 8 ft.

20 lbs x 1400 sq.ft. x 8' depth = 224,000 lbs.
(112 tons or 20 elephants) of snow on the roof.
